

Gift Aid Declaration

Jubilee Church Solihull is a registered charity (1157124) and is able to claim Gift Aid on donations made by UK tax payers. If you would like us to do this on your donations please complete your details below after ensuring that you comply with the following requirements.

- 1. You must pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax that Jubilee Church Solihull claims on your donations in the tax year (currently 25p for each £1.00 you give).
- 2. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income or capital gains equal to the tax that Jubilee Church Solihull reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 4).
- 3. Please notify Jubilee Church Solihull of any change of address while the declaration is still valid
- 4. You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying Jubilee Church Solihull (in writing it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation.
- 5. If you pay income tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment Form.
